


Personal DailyWalk

You will recognize these verses from our mid-week 'Is it I, Lord?' series. Continue reflecting on those who have inspired us in our walk with Christ as we head toward the cross.

March 23-29, 2020

Monday: Isaiah 53:4-9 Reflect on your sins that have been cast out and onto Jesus. Pray in thanksgiving for being made clean through the death and resurrection of Christ.

Tuesday: Psalm 145 Reflect on the truth of the greatness and the goodness of God. Pray that you are able to live out verse 21 with a clean and whole heart for God.

Wednesday: Genesis 12:1-9 Reflect on where God is sending you so that He may bless you and you may be a blessing to others. Pray for these blessings to come.

Thursday: Psalm 37:1-9 Oh boy, I know I am in trouble just by the title of this Psalm - *Exhortation to Patience and Trust*. Reflect on your lack of patience and/or your anger toward others and if that is a reflection of your trust in God. Pray over the full Psalm, listening for what God speaks to your heart.

Friday: 1 Kings 18:30-40 Reflect on your similarity to the Israelites in the need to see God's presence in a big way in order to trust and believe. What may you be missing when you overlook God's presence in the little things. Pray to see God's presence in all of life, not just in the big things.

Saturday: Psalm 22:25-31 This portion of the Psalm makes me think of the Doxology - *Praise God from whom all blessings flow. Praise Him all creatures here below. Praise Him above ye heavenly hosts. Praise Father, Son, and Holy Ghost*. When I looked it up, I didn't realize there was more to the song. Sunday: John 11:40-45 Again, we believe in seeing the big things. It appears that God uses the big things to bring in the people, but also, the big things bring about the plot that ultimately leads to our salvation. Pray in hope for what man means for evil, God will use for good, not only in the past, but today and in the future.

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
